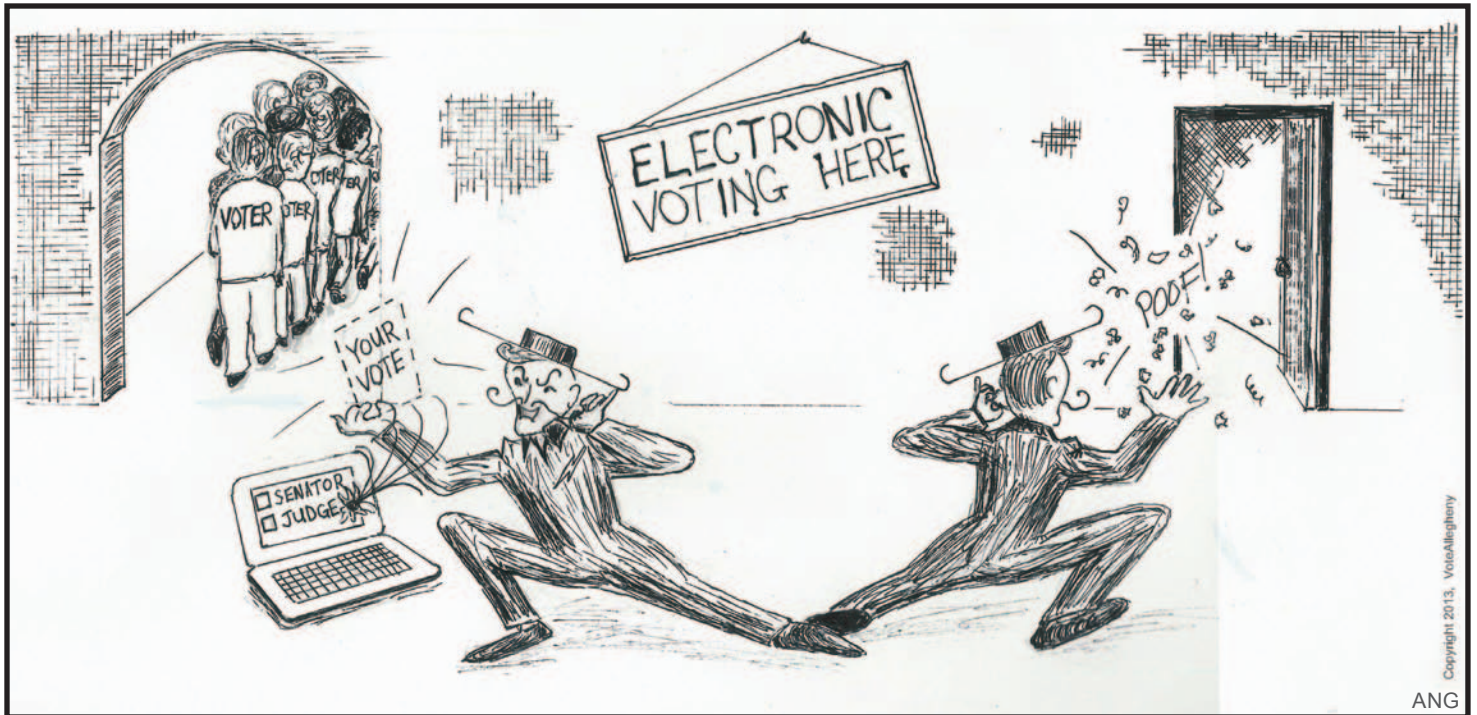


Keep military votes secure!

Keep military votes secure!

Let our Pennsylvania senators know: Internet voting cannot be done securely, so we don't want it!

We care about our military and overseas personnel, and want their votes - and ours - to be safe, secure, recountable, and anonymous. Pennsylvania laws require no less! And electronic voting cannot sufficiently provide any of these requirements.

University of Michigan grad students hacked Washington, D.C.'s Internet voting system. They caused all the votes to be cast for famous robots, while they fended off international intruders, until the D.C. officials finally noticed the rigged vote – when a voter happened to mention that the computer played the Michigan Fight Song whenever a vote was cast. Washington, D.C., has cancelled adoption of Internet voting.

Ohio has outlawed Internet voting.

Internet and phone lines in foreign countries are not secure. We cannot make them secure. Veterans agree. Computer scientists agree.

We want *all* our votes to count! Fix SB 976. Keep military votes secure.
